Thunderbird Global Initiative Office will inform you of the date and time for a counseling session - either in person or online - via email.

Counseling (to be held within 14 days from the application)

At the counseling, we will advise you on your major,

how to prepare for application, and the flow of the application procedure.

ASU Application & Required Documents (within 14 days from the counseling)

Admission Requirements

- minimum 3.0 GPA (Your school transcripts will be calculated into GPA by ASU.)
- English proficiency: minimum 61 on TOEFL or minimum 6.0 on IELTS
- * You can resubmit test scores until the final deadline.
- * A separate online application to Arizona State University (ASU) is required.
- * Applications will be submitted online to ASU and all required documents must be mailed.

 Our staff will assist you with the application process.

Required Documents

- School transcript in English or IB score English test scores:
 - TOEFL or IELTS taken within 2 years

all subjects in high school + math from the final year of Junior High School

English test scores:

TOEFL or IELTS taken within 2 years

Required Documents

- School transcript in English or IB score
 - English test scores: TOEFL or IELTS taken within 2 years

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
Score of at least 61 (iBT). ASU's institutional code is 4007. ASU accepts only electronic copies of the TOEFL score report. International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
Overall band score of the academic test of at least 6.0. The general training exam is not accepted. No institutional code is needed

MY ASU ID

An ID, with which you can log into your personal portal site "My ASU" to check your application result and further steps towards admission, will be issued after completing an online application.

Results (to be posted in order of application)

Your application result will be posted on the ASU portal site.

COE Application (by late April)

Apply for a Certificate of Eligibility at your local immigration office.

Pre-application Form [final application]

(to be submitted by 31st March 2025)

ASU Online application and all required documents must be submitted with or before the final application.

Admission (to be completed by late April 2025)

Visa Application (May)

Apply for a student visa at a Japanese embassy or consulate in your region.

Please reserve a flight ticket and let us know your arrival date, time and flight number.

English Program (April to July)

This English Program is an optional* "English preparation program". Until the start of the semester in August, students will be able to learn academic English online to prepare for the start of the classes.

Application required

For those who do not have an English proficiency test score, you can meet the English admission criteria by taking an 8-week intensive online English program and achieving a score of 80% or higher on the final exam.
